**Trip to Stockley Farm, Arley, Cheshire
Friday 27 April 2018**

I am pleased to inform you that a trip is being organised for the Year 10 GCSE Food Preparation and Nutrition students to attend a day at Stockley Farm, Arley, Cheshire (www.stockleyfarm.co.uk). The trip will take place on **Friday 27 April 2018**.

The focus of the day will be "Farm to Fork" and students will be able to:-

- see some of the crops grown on the farm, discuss organic farming methods and the impact they have upon the environment.
- meet some of the young stock on the farm, discuss selective breeding and also tour the milking parlour.
- get the chance to meet all animals including pigs, calves and goats and discuss how they are used in the food chain. They will also be able to meet our ponies, rabbits and guinea pigs and help to feed some of the animals.

Following the trip, during their next practical lesson, students will be given the opportunity to make their own soft cheese.

The students will travel by school minibus, leaving school at approximately **9.20am** and returning at approximately **3.00pm**. The cost of this trip is **£13.00** inclusive of transport. This is a voluntary contribution, however, we rely on payment in order to run the trip.

Own clothes can be worn but due to the outdoor activities sensible flat footwear, and warm waterproof clothing is required. Please bring a packed lunch.

In order to secure a place on the trip your daughter must bring their payment and the consent slip to the finance office between **8:30am and 9:00am**. **Please note that the payment is non-refundable.** Payment must be paid by **Thursday 15 March 2018**.

The visit can be paid on-line through ParentMail. If you have not registered for ParentMail and would like to do so, please contact the school. Alternatively, cash and cheques (made payable to Prenton High School) are still accepted.
