Year 10 Mentoring Programme

Liverpool John Moores University has partnered with Shaping Futures, The Merseyside Collaborative Outreach Programme, to introduce an inspiring mentoring programme for students at Prenton High School.

The mentoring programme aims to raise aspirations of young people through hands on interactive sessions with a particular emphasis on Maths and English attainment at GCSE. It will cover the importance of Maths and English GCSEs when making choices for the future and, where possible, it will provide Maths and English revision sessions. The goal is to ensure that students have a better understanding of further education and career opportunities.

The sessions will aim to get students thinking about their future in education, their career prospects and should increase their knowledge and aspirations in relation to attending Sixth Form College and University.

The University will send a team of trained mentors to work with Prenton students over a period of 5 weeks. The sessions will take place on **Wednesdays from 3.30 to 4.30pm, starting Wednesday 28 February.**
