As part of our commitment to informing your daughter about post 16 pathways we have organised a trip to the Young Chamber Career & Skills Show at The Hive Youth Zone on **Tuesday 6 March from 2.00pm – 3.15 pm.**

The event is for young people aged 14-24 years to inspire, enthuse and motivate them to think about their prospective careers and the employment options available to them. The Young Chamber Career & Skills Show is organised by Wirral Young Chamber and is part of a government funded national project to deliver events to young people through the local Chambers of Commerce nationally.

Students will leave school at **1.45pm** and travel to The Hive by coach where they will be able to meet with a wide range of local businesses, employed young people and local Colleges and Universities.
