'Big Bang North-West' Young Scientist and Engineer Competition'. – Tuesday July 10

Your daughter has been selected to enter the 'Big Bang Northwest Young Scientist and Engineer Competition'. This exciting event will take place on **Tuesday 10 July 2018**. The venue for the competition is 'The Big Bang Northwest STEM Fair', taking place in the Liverpool Echo Arena Exhibition Centre.

During the competition, Prenton students will present their work in developing a new and exciting method to encourage toddlers to brush their teeth and increase oral health. The presentation will be judged by industry and academic professionals, and will be in competition with other schools from the North West. Your daughter will be accompanied by myself for the whole of the day.

Students will require a packed lunch on the day of the visit and a drink in a non-breakable container. Students entitled to free school meals may collect a packed lunch on the day before the trip. (Please indicate on reply slip). **School uniform must be worn.** Please wear an appropriate coat for the weather.

We will be travelling by MerseyRail train and by foot to get to the venue. This will be a longer day than normal, taking into account travel to and from the venue. In order to arrive at the venue on time it is important that you are able to drop off, and collect, your daughter at Rockferry Train Station. Please note all students must be collected.
