**Ice World School Open Day at Cammell Laird
Friday 27 September 2019**

I am writing to inform you that your child has been selected to attend the Ice World School Open Day at Cammell Laird on **Friday 27 September 9.00am – 12.00midday**. This is an immersive and exciting festival of discovery to celebrate the official naming of the new polar research ship for Britain.
